



Help with exclusion criteria: Jodi shares that exclusions for IVs in SUD isn't common b. Info about symposium in November Meeting with DDAP on 7/3 with Jodi Skiles and Sue Duff. COMPLETE. a. Sarah will send a f/u to Jodi re: SCA contacts and OMHSAS contact. Last email from Jodi on 8/4. Kellie Mainzer, contact at OMHSAS, is no longer there. b. Sarah will send a f/u to Erica Nocho, oversees SCAs, re: scheduling a meeting and a list of facilities in each SCA. c. Sarah will send a f/u to Michelle (mdenk@pacounties.org), coordinator of SCA Association, re: scheduling a meeting and a list of facilities in each SCA. Jodi sent email to Michelle on 8/4. Identify a champion within a state agency	Complete for SUD In progress for MH	SUD: Jodi Skiles (joskiles@pa.gov), Director of DDAP Bureau Program Licensure, has offered to be a potential champ. Jodi recommends that in the event of a denial, first contact: 1. 1800 622 4357 (HELP) Hotline 2. Single County Authorities (SCAs). They are the local entities that support the SUD for their counties. Collect 2-3 exclusion criteria (1 collected)	In progress	PA MH/SUD facilities for outreach Kristine has a Director of Nursing contact and will ask about exclusion criteria Script for exclusion criteria calls Exclusion criteria collected in PA HOLD: Survey to collect additional exclusion criteria in PA - still in draft form. Kristine sent thank you email on April 23 to Silver Pines and asked about connections w/ BH associations. Exclusion criteria collected across BD SUMHAC states
5. Facility education /Identify champion facilities	In progress (2)	 We've provided education sessions to: Silver Pines Treatment Center (SUD) is willing to serve as a facility champion on calls with state agencies. No exclusions for IVs. Pyramid Healthcare Inc (MH/SUD) DDAP proposal not accepted, but flagged as an opportunity for training. We should hear back directly from the DDAP training section. Kit sent f/u on Nov. 4.

Roadmap for Denials

- Step 1 Getting mental health and substance use disorder treatment (Access Toolkit)
 - Crisis resources
 - Talking with a provider about treatment options
 - Preparing for a referral to inpatient/residential treatment
 - Discussing bleeding disorders with an inpatient/residential facility
- Step 2 Responding to a denial with assistance from HTC (Provider Toolkit)
 - Support my patient's behavioral health
 - Build relationships with BH facilities
 - Make effective referrals to BH facilities
 - Take action after a denial of care
 - Partner with a BH facility during my patient's stay
